The rapidly increasing imports of beef, and particularly the imports of lowcost foreign beef, has created serious problems for the Hawaiian beef industry as well as the industry nationally. Hawaii being the closest and most lucrative port of entry to the United States continues to receive large shipments of Antipodal beef.

Hawaii's beef industry has a long, colorful and traditional history. It adds over \$10 million annually to the State's economy and represents 22% of all sales

of diversified agricultural products.
