Electrical equipment, appliances	Safety and technical standards	Significant, 1966 U. S. exports approximately \$2.7 million. Est. of increase not possible	Legal but not removable	15 European countries recently adopted common safety standards for electrical equipment. Regulations are imposed for safety reasons.
Pharmaceuticals, drugs, poisons	Safety Standards	Not significant, 1966 U. S. exports \$0.7 million.	Legal, but not negotiable	These products may only be approved for importation by druggists, manufacturers, wholesalers, etc. Proprietary medicine labels must bear quantitative formulas, dosage, date of production and manufacturers' name.
