Pharmaceuticals, drugs and poisons	Pharmaceutical	Not significant. 1966 U.S. export \$2.7 million.	Legal, but not negotiable	Products may be imported only by approved druggists, drug wholesalers or manufacturers. Regulations applied to protect the public health and welfare.
