## Condensed Milk

Of the countries included in this study, 92 applied import duties and/or other entry charges on condensed milk. These averaged 12.47 cents per pound.

Argentina's duty, at 83.50 cents per pound, was the highest. This, added to other charges of 1.10 cents, brought the total entry cost to 84.60 cents. The second highest duty was Portugal's 25.40 cents, followed by Mozambique's 21.82. In both Ecuador and Italy, the duty also exceeded 19 cents per pound.

In the United States, the import duty was 1.75 cents.

Nine foreign countries admitted condensed milk free of duty or other entry charges.
