- o Has the activity developed a self-evaluation technique to ascertain whether its manpower control and utilization activities are achieving results?
- (e) Specialized Reporting Instructions.
 - 1 In reporting, the inspector should focus on impact -- concrete results, significant problems, weaknesses, or achievements.
 - The inspector should not describe controls imposed from above except when these are not achieving results, are creating management problems, or are encouraging forms of evasion such as improper use of contract personnel, improper temporary appointments, etc.
