The endorsement described herein may not be cancelled without cancellation of the policy (or policies) to which it is attached. Such cancellation may be effected by the Company or the Insured giving thirty (30) days' notice in writing to the Interstate Commerce Commission at its office in Washington, D. C., said thirty (30) days' notice to commence to run from the date notice is actually received at the office of said Commission.
