PROGRAM.—PUBLIC LANDS HIGHWAYS (LIQUIDATION OF CONTRACT AUTHORIZATION)

A. Statutory or administrative authority for the program

Public lands are unappropriated or unreserved public lands, nontaxable Indian lands, or other Federal reservations. Authorizing legislation provides that funds shall be used to assist States with large areas of public lands in the improvement of sections of main roads—principally on the Federal-aid highway system which States otherwise may find difficult to finance.

Authority for this program is contained in the Biennial Highway Acts. (Public

Law 89-574) (23 U.S.C. 101 et seq.)
