COAST GUARD-OPERATING EXPENSES

PROGRAM AND PERFORMANCE

The Coast Guard employs multipurpose vessels, aircraft, and shore units, strategically located along the coasts and inland waterways of the United States and in selected areas overseas to carry out the duties specified in title 14, United States Code.

Direct program—1. Search and rescue.—Most Coast Guard operating facilities have the capacity for promoting saftey on or over the high seas and on waters subject to the jurisdiction of the United States. The Coast Guard performs any and all acts necessary to rescue and aid persons and save property placed in jeopardy due to marine and aircraft disaster or due to floods and ice conditions (14 U.S.C. 88). Coast Guard activities in the area of search and rescue fall within the national SAR plan and other agreements.
