

if we can evolve techniques that would facilitate the processes. If we can do so, we certainly would be delighted.

Senator MUSKIE. We would be glad to work with you. The ideas embodied in the bill are in a sense over-simplifications that are attractive. But I think as we have worked with this we have learned that the oversimplified formula doesn't necessarily work. I think there is enough in the bill to commend itself to further effort on our part and yours to try to work this out.

Mr. HUGHES. I certainly agree, Mr. Chairman.

Senator MUSKIE. I think, then, that is all for this morning, Mr. Hughes.

Mr. HUGHES. Thank you, Mr. Chairman.

Senator MUSKIE. Thank you both very much.

We will be back to you, I am sure.

Mr. HUGHES. Thank you.
