

K. Through the Committee on Reformulation of the Code of Professional Conduct reflect the critical responsibilities of the planning profession for responding creatively and vigorously to the profession's responsibility for enhancing equality of opportunity.

L. Insist that all governmental agencies, through practices, public statements and directives, promote agency practices which directly encourage equal opportunity in housing, employment, and all other areas with which they deal and secure full compliance with the laws, orders and Constitutional provisions requiring non-discrimination in all federally-assisted programs.

M. Direct all AIP Divisions and Committees to develop detailed policies and recommendations needed in order to achieve these goals.
