Finally, section 807(b) provides in the case of federally-assisted the benefit of us all. projects that costs of relocation would be included in project costs and Federal financial assistance would be provided to the same extent as other project costs, except that the Federal agency would contribute the first \$25,000 of the cost of providing a relocation payment to any displaced person. The effect of the proposal would be to have the Federal Government assume almost all relocation payments.

We believe that relocation payments are an essential element of project cost and see no reason to exempt the first \$25,000 from the usual sharing requirements. We believe strongly that relocation payments

should be shared as other highway project costs.

I thank you for this opportunity to testify on this legislation, Mr. Turner and I, to the extent of our ability, are prepared to answer questions.
