- organizations, and individuals other than the individual who is the subject of clearance for access to a defense facility or classified information, when based upon (1) reports of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Central Intelligence Agency, or of any other investigative agency of the United States, (2) reports or findings of congressional or State legislative investigations, (3) matters of public or common 8 knowledge, or (4) any other information or source of in-9 formation which the President or his designee for that pur-10 pose determines to be substantial and reliable. Nothing contained in this subsection shall be construed to support a demand by any such individual (including an individual who is 12 13 the subject of clearance) or organization for access to investi-14 gative reports of any agency of the United States, or to 15 require the disclosure of information, or the source of any 16 information, when such disclosure would be deemed contrary 17 to the national interest. 18
  - "(f) In determining the significance to be given for the purposes of this section to the organizational membership or associations of any individual who is the subject of clearance for access to a defense facility or classified information, but with due regard to the prohibitions of section 5 (a) (1) (C), consideration shall be given to—

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- "(1) the character and history of that organization;
- "(2) the time during which such person was a
