available to such persons to influence or deter, or to attempt to influence or deter, the formulation or implementation of any policy or the performance of any function or operation which may affect the national security; and "(2) the danger of the occurrence of sabotage within such facility arising from (A) access, by persons admitted thereto, to premises at which functions or operations which may affect the national security are or may be performed or carried into effect, (B) access by such persons to premises or instrumentalities for control or communication which are necessary for the maintenance and normal operation of basic services required by such facility, including (without limitation) the services of heating, lighting, air conditioning, water supply, and sewerage, and (C) access by such persons to any other means for the commission of acts of sabotage or for the acquisition of knowledge which would provide opportunity for or facilitate the commission of such acts. All determinations made under this subsection shall be subject to judicial review pursuant to chapter 7, title 5, United
