Also present: Herbert Roback, staff administrator; Douglas Dahlin, counsel, Joseph Luman, defense analyst, and Paul Ridgely, investigator.

Mr. HOLIFIELD. The committee will be in order.

This morning we resume again with hearings on military supply systems with Army witnesses. Following the hearing last Wednesday, we understand that General Heiser and General Jones are detached to proceed to duties in Vietnam. We understand that Brig. Gen. John Klingenhagen, who has succeeded to General Heiser's position as Assistant Deputy Chief of Staff, Logistics Supply and Maintenance, Department of the Army, has returned today.

In addition, Maj. Gen. Frank D. Miller, who is the Assistant Deputy Chief of Staff for Logistics, for doctrines, systems, and readiness, is also present. General Miller has a brief statement.
