1 lands and waters under his jurisdiction within the boundary of the recreation area in accordance with applicable laws of 2 the United States and of the State of Washington, except 3 that the Secretary may designate zones where, and establish 4 periods when, no hunting or fishing shall be permitted for 5 reasons of public safety, administration, fish and wildlife 6 management, or public use and enjoyment. Except in emer-7 gencies, any regulations of the Secretary pursuant to this 8 section shall be put into effect only after consultation with 9

the Department of Game of the State of Washington.

SEC. 501. The distributive shares of the respective counties of receipts from the national forests from which the national park and recreation area are created, as paid under the provisions of the Act of May 23, 1908 (35 Stat. 260), as amended (16 U.S.C. 500), shall not be affected by the elimination of lands from such national forests by the enactment of this Act.

SEC. 502. Where any Federal lands included in the park or recreation area are legally occupied or utilized on the effective date of this Act for any purpose, pursuant to a contract, lease, permit, or license issued or authorized by any department, establishment, or agency of the United States, the Secretary shall permit the persons holding such privileges to continue in the exercise thereof, subject to the
