

1 exchange the Secretary may accept title to any non-Federal
2 property within the boundaries of the park, and in exchange
3 therefor he may convey to the grantor of such property any
4 federally owned property under his jurisdiction in the State
5 of Washington which he classifies as suitable for exchange or
6 other disposal. The values of the properties so exchanged
7 either shall be approximately equal, or if they are not ap-
8 proximately equal the value shall be equalized by the pay-
9 ment of cash to the grantor or to the Secretary as the cir-
10 cumstances require.

11 SEC. 3. (a) In furtherance of the purposes of this Act
12 and subject to valid existing rights there are hereby estab-
13 lished the Mount Baker Recreation Area, the Ross Lake
14 Recreation Area, the Lake Chelan Recreation Area, the
15 Cascade River Recreation Area, and the North Cascade
16 Highway Recreation Area, each as designated on the map
17 referred to in section 1 of this Act, comprising in the aggre-
18 gate approximately three hundred and ninety-nine thousand
19 acres.

20 (b) The recreation areas shall be administered by the
21 Secretary of Agriculture in accordance with the laws, rules,
22 and regulations applicable to the national forests in such
23 manner as in his judgment will best provide for: (1) public
24 outdoor recreation benefits; (2) conservation of scenic,
25 scientific, historic, and other values contributing to the public
