- 11 Sec. 3. (a) In furtherance of the purposes of this Act
- 12 and subject to valid existing rights there are hereby estab-
- 13 lished the Mount Baker Recreation Area, the Ross Lake
- 14 Recreation Area, the Lake Chelan Recreation Area, the
- 15 Cascade River Recreation Area, and the North Cascade
- 16 Highway Recreation Area, each as designated on the map
