The subcommittee will be in order for the consideration of H.R. 11213 by Mr. Aspinall, to settle the land claims of Alaska natives, and for other purposes; H.R. 15049 by Mr. Pollock, the Alaska Native Land Claims Settlement Act of 1968; and H.R. 17129 by Mr. Aspinall, to provide for the settlement of aboriginal land claims of Alaska natives, and for other purposes.

H.R. 17129 is substitute legislation recommended by the Department of the Interior in its report dated April 30, 1968.

Without objection, H.R. 11213, H.R. 15049, H.R. 17129, Department of the Interior report dated April 30, 1968, and an executive communication dated June 15, 1967, will be included in the record at this point.
