(c) "Native group" means any village, community, or 1 association in Alaska composed of twenty-five or more 3 Natives and approved by the Secretary. 4 DECLARATION OF POLICY 5 SEC. 3. Congress finds and declares that there is an 6 immediate need for a fair and just settlement of land claims by Natives of Alaska, and that a fair and just settlement should provide for (a) a grant to each Native group of title to their present village sites, and to additional lands in the 10 vicinity of the villages that will be needed for reasonable 11 community expansion to fulfill future economic and social 12 requirements, (b) a reasonable payment to Native groups for the purpose of enhancing their present and future welfare, 13 and (c) exclusive Native hunting, fishing, trapping, and 14 15 berrypicking on Federal lands not granted to the Native groups. It is the purpose of this Act to provide for such 16 17 settlement. 18 DECLARATION OF SETTLEMENT 19 SEC. 4. The provisions of this Act shall be regarded as 20 full and final settlement of any and all claims against the 21 United States based upon aboriginal right, title, use, or occupancy of lands in Alaska by Natives, including claims pending before the Indian Claims Commission that are based
