

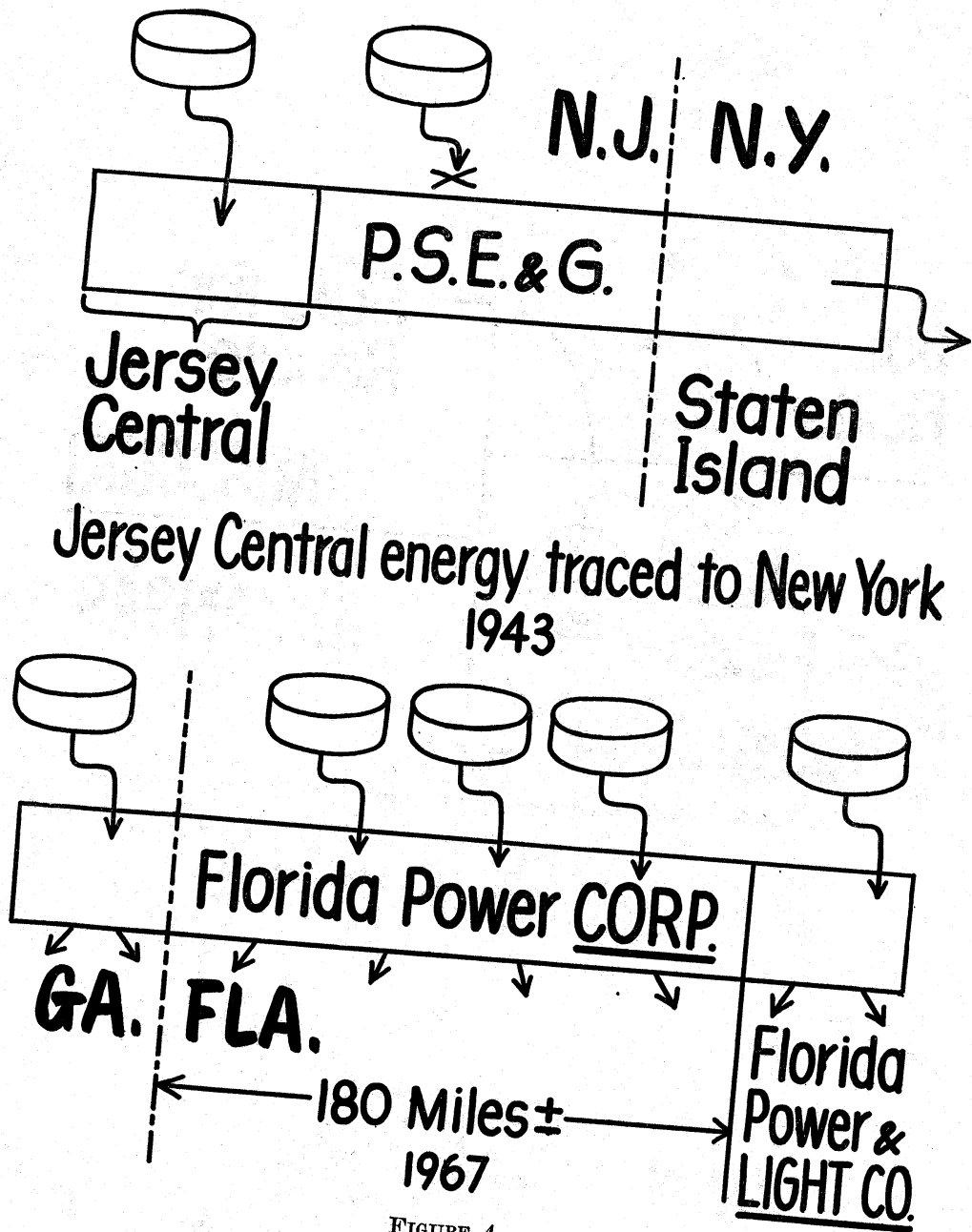

Now, we would like to next briefly describe the situation in Texas that we have. We first describe the number of systems which are partly in Texas and partly in other States and these have been illustrated by crosshatched areas here (see fig. 2). The El Paso system, the Southwestern Public Service Co. system in the Panhandle, Southwestern Electric Power Co. System on the Arkansas corner, and the Gulf States system; all of these systems are within Texas in part, but within another State in part.

Now, separate from that group and unconnected to it except in emergency, but all interconnected with each other, are these systems which we have listed here. The first—the LCRA system—is a State authority; the general manager of which, Mr. Gideon, testified yesterday before
