agreed between said Pueblo and said lessees or permittees. The Secretary of the Interior is hereby authorized to disburse, from the tribal funds in the Treasury of the United States to the credit of said tribe, so much thereof as may be necessary to pay for the purchase of any rights or improvements owned by non-Indians on said lands, and for the acquisition or relinquishment of any leases or permits held by non-Indians on any of said lands.

(d) The Indian Claims Commission is directed to determine in accordance with the provisions of section 2 of the Act of August 13, 1946 (60 Stat. 1049, 1050), the extent to which the value of the interest in land conveyed by this Act should be credited to the United States or should be set off against any claim of the Taos Indians against the United States.
