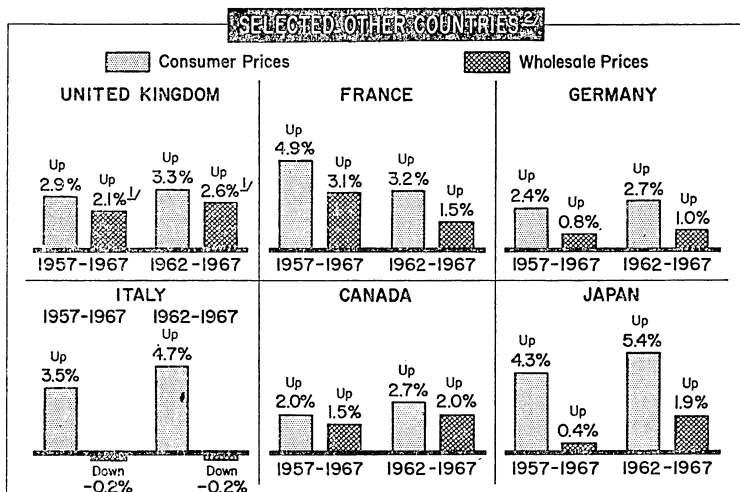
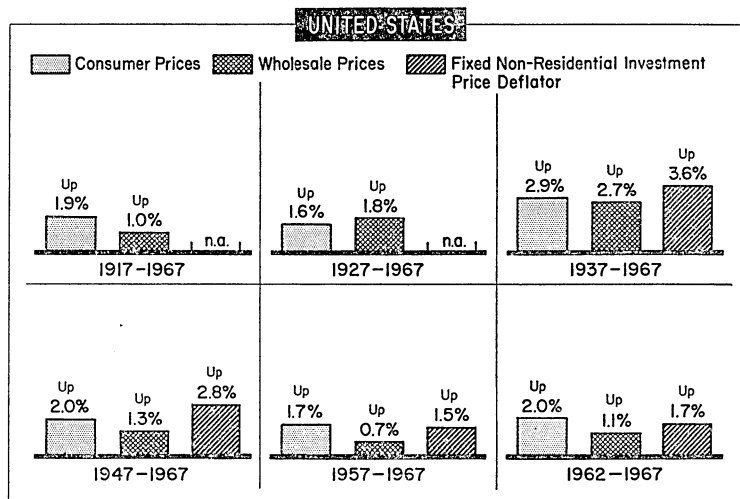


SELECTED PRICE TRENDS, 1917-1967 U.S. AND SELECTED OTHER COUNTRIES
