

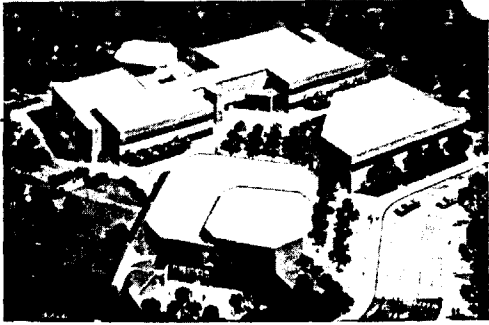

I am in receipt of the form of Order granting partial consolidation which was prepared by Mr. Hill.

I object to the reference to compliance with the Judgment filed July 9, 1976, and the Order entered in Oakwood at Madison v. Township of Madison.
