

Dear Judge Serpentelli:

This will acknowledge your letter of September 19th, 1984. In response thereto, you are at liberty to utilize the report in any manner you wish and, of course, it was the purpose of my sending it to you that you share the same with any of the other interested parties in Mount Laurel litigation.

Regarding the "rezoning process" in South Plainfield, it would appear now to have been temporarily or permanently ended. The local Planning Board has postponed scheduled hearings with respect to the rezoning of the parcels specifically designated in the Judgment. The last postponement was made without designating a future date for additional hearings. This would appear to signal the end of any compliance process with respect to the Consent Judgment.
