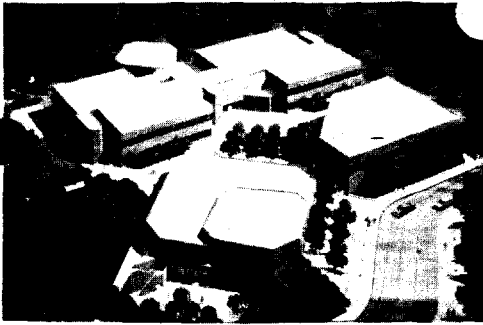

Dear Judge Serpentelli:

I am in receipt of a copy of Barbara J. Williams' letter dated September 20, 1984 regarding the above referenced matter.

I assure you that the Township of Old Bridge has been working diligently to consider all aspects of ordinance revision, and presently has its professionals reviewing possible revisions to application procedures, as well as reviewing all building specifications.

As you know, Old Bridge has submitted a written proposal regarding the major aspects of the Mt. Laurel II case. A copy of this proposal was sent to you. Although I have discussed this proposal with Barbara Williams on the telephone, I have not received a written response from any other party.

In view of the fact that the Township of Old Bridge is continuing to work diligently towards ordinance revision, I strongly object to the appointment of a Master at this juncture. I believe that the parties should negotiate directly at least until the time when it appears that an agreement can not be reached.
