
Dear Judge Serpentelli:

As per Your Honor's letter of October 4, 1984, I am enclosing plaintiffs' Order for Appointment of a Master in relation to the Township of Old Bridge in the above referenced matter.

Old Bridge has not enacted the requisite ordinances as per paragraph 5 of the July 13, 1984 Order and Judgment as to Old Bridge Township. Indeed, the Resolution passed by the Township of Old Bridge Council on October 29, 1984, which is enclosed, indicates only an intent to enact such ordinances and even as to these ordinances (which do not cover all aspects of the required revisions), Council has indicated all ordinances will be passed under protest.

One hundred and ten (110) days have elapsed since the entry of the Court's Order. Accordingly, we believe it is appropriate for Ms. Lerman to be appointed as Master for revision of the ordinances of the Township of Old Bridge at this time.
