I have met with all the parties in this case twice -- December 17 and December 28. In addition I had the opportunity to have a short meeting with the Mayor and Council of Old Bridge.


I believe these meetings have helped to clarify those issues of actual disagreement and those issues which have been based on misinterpreted communications. Meetings with the utilities authority, the planning board and the developers are set for the first week in January, and for the entire group on January 14. At the latter meeting it should be possible to establish a schedule for early settlement.

All of the parties agree with my request for an extension of the 45-day period established by you on November 13, 1984, to January 31, 1985.

I feel confident that all parties are working toward a settlement in good faith, and that the additional time will be spent productively to that end.
