In response to Paragraph 3 of Mr. Hall's letter to you of May 14, we wish to note that the Urban League plaintiffs would have no objection to Planning Board processing of the first 900 units of the O & Y project under new agreed-upon procedures as long as that proposal included a 16 percent set-aside for low and moderate income units and as long as it is clear that such separate processing of the first piece of the project would not increase the costs of or significantly delay the overall processing.
