
Re; Old Bridge Township Settlement

Dear Judge Serpentelli:

At a public hearing last evening, Woodhaven Village requested a continuation to July 8, 1986 in order to review the report submitted by Dr. Norbert Psuty to the Planning Board. This report indicates that a "worst case" wetlands delineation includes approximately 200 acres not identified by Woodhaven Village in their application to the Planning Board. Modification of the development plan may be necessary in light of these findings and therefore, the Planning Board agreed to adjourn the matter.
