Dear Judge Serpentelli:

This is to confirm the position indicated by the Planning Board of the Township of Old Bridge at the case management conference conducted by Your Honor on July 14, 1986. It was indicated that the Planning Board had authorized its solicitor to file motions to set aside the settlement entered into between the municipality, planning board and the plaintiffs based upon either mutual or unilateral mistake concerning the extent of wetlands on the subject sites. Additionally, the Planning Board will move to reduce the fair share number to that proposed by the Affordable Housitg Council (which is expected adopt the guidelines which include the fair share number, on IAugust 4, 1986) and, possibly move to transfer the matter to the Affordable Housing Council.

In compliance with the Court's direction, the Planning Board will file motions returnable for the second in September 1986.
