Dear Mr. Hutt:

I wish to acknowledge your letter of April 2, 1987, and Mr. Convery's letter of April 3, 1987, as well as prior correspondence from Mr. Hall and others.

In my view, it would be premature to hear any Motion regarding the Old Bridge matter pending resolution of the wetlands issue or at least a report from Carla Lerman. That would include the Motion with regard to modification of the judgment relating to Oakwood at Madison. Until I have a clear picture as to the Township's capacity to accomplish its fair share, I do not believe it appropriate to engage in any modification. Of course, if counsel involved in the Oakwood at Madison motion wish to appear on April 9 to be heard with regard to the tentative conclusion I have reached, they may do so. However, they should advise me in advance if they still wish to have a hearing on that motion.


