As Your Honor is aware, this office represents O&Y Old Bridge Development Corp. with respect to its proposed development in Old Bridge Township. I am enclosing a letter sent to Mr. Norman, the attorney for the Old Bridge Township Planning Board, which indicates our concerns as to the mounting delays on this project. We have not objected to reasonable opportunties for the parties to review the facts, and support the Court's request for a report from the master.
