Dear Mr. Convery:

Pursuant to the terms of the January 24, 1986 Order, the Township is required to provide the Civic League with quarterly reports as set forth at paragraph 7(e)i-v of that Order. These reports are to include "details on all monies received and expended by the Affordable Housing Trust Fund." Section 7(e)iv.


In addition, quarterly reports from each developer providing lower income housing are to be obtained by the Township Agency and forwarded to the Civic League pursuant to Section A.10.1 of Appendix A. An annual report is also to be prepared by the Agency no later than June 30 of each calendar year during which low income housing has been constructed in accordance with Section A.10.5 of Appendix A. We have been advised by C. Roy Epps, President of the Civic League, that as of this date, none of the required reports has been received.

Moreover, paragraph 7(f) of the Order provides for the payment of a fee of \$30 for each lower income unit approved for construction. This fee is to be paid directly to the Civic League for monitoring purposes. Mr. Epps has advised that no such fees have been received by the Civic League.
