Dear Judge Serpentelli:

The Civic League plaintiffs object to the form of Order submitted by Thomas Norman, Esq. First, Your Honor did not order that the Court's oral opinion be incorporated in the Order. Second, the third provision of Mr. Norman's proposed form of Order, ("This Court does not retain jurisdiction of this matter") is redundant in view of the second provision, which transfers the matter to the Council on Affordable Housing.
