
Dear Judge Serpentelli:

Pursuant to paragraph 5 of the Order of the Court dated July 13, 1984, representatives of the Township of Old Bridge, the developer plaintiffs, O&Y and Woodhaven, and the Urban League met on several occasions to discuss aspects of the revision of the ordinances of the Township of Old Bridge. The parties have continued to share ideas regarding this process. The Township of Old Bridge has submitted a proposal regarding portions of the ordinances to be revised. The Urban League has provided an oral response to this proposal and has drafted its written response to the Township of Old Bridge.

While significant progress is being made, I must report to the Court that at the present time, no concrete agreement exists between the parties as to many of the items set forth by the Township of Old Bridge in its proposal. In addition, no specific proposals have been made to date by the Township of Old Bridge with respect to revision of its procedures and elimination of cost generating factors from the ordinances.

I am hopeful that all of the parties will continue to work diligently to secure an agreement as to all of the foregoing matters. However, given the fact that the deadline for reaching such an argument set forth in the Judgment of July 13, 1984 has expired, I believe the appointment of a Master at this juncture would be of assistance to all of the parties as we continue to work toward this goal. Accordingly, based upon the terms of the existing Order and Judgment, I respectfully request that the Court appoint a Master to aid in the process of revision of the ordinances of the Township of Old Bridge.


