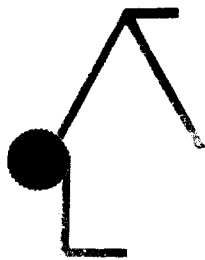

Re: Urban League of Greater New Brunswick v. Borough of Carteret

Dear Judge Serpentelli:

This is in response to Mr. Lefkowitz' letter of October 17, 1984 requesting a four week extension to comply with the Consent Order in this matter.

It is the position of the Urban League plaintiffs that enactment of an ordinance to implement the Consent Order need not, and should not, await adoption of an entirely new zoning ordinance, if such adoption will significantly delay approval of an ordinance that will bring the Township into compliance with Mount Laurel II.

Nevertheless, because it appears that the Township is proceeding in good faith with the preparation of a compliant ordinance, I have no objection to Mr. Lefkowitz' request for a short extension of time. I presume that the Township will move forward with all deliberate speed toward completion of a proposed ordinance which will fully implement the Consent Order in this matter.


