Gentlemen:

I have received a copy of Mr. Diegnan's letters of November 9, 1984 to each of you. I trust that you understand that while the Court has removed all restrictions against application processes, there are specific conditions which must be included in any approval of those properties which have been designated as potential Mount Laurel sites by the Court appointed expert. Those conditions will be set forth in an order to be submitted to the Court by Barbara J. Williams, Esq. They include the conditions set forth in the previous order of the Court dated September 11, 1984 plus some additional factors. In fairness to any applicant, I believe that it would be appropriate to notify an applicant in advance of the conditions of the court order and the fact that both of your Boards would be required to impose those conditions if approval is granted.
