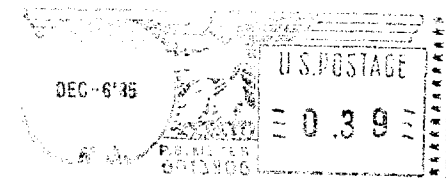

Dear Counsel*:

The Supreme Court has instructed me to convey additional scheduling information to you in respect of the above appeals. First, the Court has permitted the Public Advocate to delay filing of his brief until Monday, December 9, 1985. Second, the Court has granted an application by the Senate and Assembly Minorities for leave to participate amici curiae in these matters. The Order granting that application is enclosed. Although the Order provides that the brief of amici is to be filed on or before December 11, 1985, the Court has agreed to extend the time for the filing of that brief until December 17, 1985.

Because of the delay in the filing of the briefs of the above and because the Attorney General was previously given until December 11, 1985 to file his brief, the Court is affording all parties the opportunity to respond to the briefs of the Public Advocate and the Attorney General by December 17, 1985. A single brief, which may be in the form of a letter, may be used to respond to both. Please note that the filing of this brief is optional.

Any party may submit a response to the brief of the amici on or before December 23, 1985. Again, you may use a letter brief form, and the submission of such a brief is optional.

Third, the Court has determined that it will hear oral argument in five of the appeals that have been certified. Those are:

- A-122 The Hills Development Co. v. Bernards Twp.
- A-124 Urban League v. Carteret (Cranbury)
- A-125 Morris Co. Fair Housing Council v. Boonton (Denville)
- A-128 Morris Co. Fair Housing Council v. Boonton (Randolph)
- A-132 Rivell v. Tewksbury Twp.

The remaining appeals will be decided on the basis of the briefs submitted and in the light of the argument on the five cases listed above.

The Court will hear oral argument on Monday, January 6, 1986. You should also keep your calendar clear for the possible continuation of argument on Tuesday, January 7, 1986.


Counsel in cases listed for argument will find a form for completion. Please note that in cases with multiple parties the Court will require a consolidation of argument. Counsel in those cases should confer and submit the names of no more than two attorneys for each side. Those attorneys will share the time requested. The maximum time under the Rules is 45 minutes.

The Attorney General, Public Advocate, and counsel for the amici curiae noted above will not be required to share time with counsel in any particular action.

Although the formal sequence of argument has not yet been established, a tentative list has counsel for the appealing municipalities first, followed by respondent Tewksbury, the Attorney General, the Public Advocate, appellant Rivell, the respondent builders, and amici curiae. Counsel should confer with each other to eliminate duplication in argument.

If the Court determines that the argument sequence listed above should be modified or other changes made, I will be contact with you.
