
Dear Judge Serpentelli:

As you are aware, Your Honor's Letter Opinion dated July 27, 1984 ordering the Township of Monroe to revise its Land Use Regulations within ninety days of that date, has been extended to December 1, 1984, by virtue of Your Honor's letter dated October 30, 1984. At a meeting of the governing body held on November 26, 1984, the governing body, which will conduct a public hearing on Saturday, December 1, 1984, requested that the undersigned again petition Your Honor for a further extension of your Order for an additional thirty-day period.

The Monroe Township governing body has continued to conduct Saturday meetings and has recently included an additional week-day meeting in order to expedite its re-zoning process. Carla Lerman has attended each of these sessions of the governing body. In my opinion, the Council has achieved significant progress and I would anticipate an appropriate draft of a zoning ordinance suitable for introduction within the next thirty-day period. It is my understanding that Ms. Lerman joins in this request by the Township and I know of no opposition to this request by the Urban League.
