Dear Judge Serpentelli:

Last evening the governing body of the Township of Monroe met in closed session with Carla Lerman and Professional Planner Carl Hintz at which time Carl Hintz was formally retained for the purpose of preparing the Township's compliance package for submission to the Court.

Following the retention of Mr. Hintz, the governing body spent several hours under the direction of Mr. Hintz evaluating seventeen site selection criteria for the fifteen development proposals presently under consideration by the Council.

At the conclusion of this exercise, the governing body directed Mr. Hintz to commence preparation of the Township's compliance package as expeditiously as possible. Mr. Hintz has indicated that he will in all probability require at least three weeks to prepare such a package which will be suitable for submission to the Court.

Accordingly, the governing body of the Township of Monroe has requested that the undersigned again petition Your Honor for an additional thirty-day extension, which hopefully will be the last such request. I enclose herewith a copy of the resolution adopted by the governing body and by copy of this letter I am advising all opposing counsel of this request.
