
Dear Judge Serpentelli:

I received a copy of Eric Neisser's correspondence to the Court dated July 26, 1985, to which was attached a proposed Order regarding the Motion For Temporary Restraints heard by your Honor on July 26, 1985.

Just so that I may give my input on what I believe your Honor held on the above Motion, it is not my understanding that your Honor granted the Motion For Temporary Restraints. Rather, it is my understanding that your Honor was not willing to grant the Plaintiffs' Motion but rather, ordered that the Whittingham project can go forward, but that the developer, the Union Valley Corporation, is acting at its own peril in that the Court still has the authority to require that at some future date that the Whittingham tract provide for a 5% set-aside for low and moderate income housing.

I would appreciate a clarification from your Honor on this matter if your Honor sees a need to do so. I thank you for your Honor's attention in this matter, and I remain,
