Rather, it is my understanding that your Honor was not willing to grant the Plaintiffs' Motion but rather, ordered that the Whittingham project can go forward, but that the developer, the Union Valley Corporation, is acting at its own peril in that the Court still has the authority to require that at some future date that the Whittingham tract provide for a 5% set-aside for low and moderate income housing.
