
Dear Mr. Apuzzo,

An order had been signed by Judge Eugene Serpentelli on August 30, 1985 directing me to submit my recommendations on Monroe's compliance program by October 7, 1985; however, I have delayed that report at the direction of Judge Serpentelli, until after the October 3, 1985 hearing on Monroe's motion to transfer the Affordable Housing Council. The October 7, 1985 date has been postponed, but only long enough to give me time to renew my report of July 1985 and make further recommendations as I feel necessary. Although the Court has advised me that my recommendations are to be submitted as soon as possible, I would like to give the Township of Monroe, as well as all the other parties involved, as opportunity for further comment.
