On March 31, 1986, I received a copy of an Order executed by Your Honor on March 21, 1986. Please be advised that I did not receive a copy of this Order pursuant to the five (5) day rule.

Upon receipt, I contacted by telephone, Barbara Stark, who advised that to the best of her knowledge, a copy of the Order had been forwarded pursuant to the five (5) day rule. I advised her that I objected to Paragraph 2 of the Order and Judgment of Repose wherein it sets forth repose until July 2, 1991. I further advised that the Township position is that the order of repose should be six (6) years from the date of the Order and Judgment of Repose or March 20, 1992.
