Dear Judge Serpentelli:

We have received a copy of Mr. Gelber's letter to your Honor dated August 3, 1984 enclosing a revised proposed Consent Order as to North Brunswick Township. We are not certain as to the procedure being employed by Mr. Gelber, since the first paragraph of his letter states that the Order is being submitted "under the five-day rule," while the second paragraph states that a copy is being circulated among the interested parties for their approval. We believe that since this is a consent order, it should be circulated to all counsel for their signatures.

In any event, we ask that the Court not enter the consent order at this time. While we do not anticipate any substantial problems with the Order, we have not yet been able to review it in detail with our client to be certain that the client understands and consents to all of its terms. We expect to do this within the next week.

Also, we wish to point out that the Order refers to our client as "the Reider Company". The correct name of our client is PAST, Inc. The Order should be revised accordingly.
