This shall confirm that you advised me two weeks ago that Plainsboro basically agreed with the form and content of the Consent Order forwarded to you on November 5, 1987. You suggested that more sites than necessary be set forth at paragraph 3(f) so as to allow Plainsboro some flexibility in its negotiations with the owners of those sites. Assuming that all of the listed sites are acceptable to the Civic League, plaintiffs certainly have no problem with this. Moreover, you indicated that the schedule set forth in the same paragraph was overly ambitious, and that you would forward proposed dates representing a compromise of both parties' positions.
