
Dear Ms. Williams:

Reference is made to your letter dated December 12, 1984. I spoke with Bob Rosa today and he informs me that all of the necessary revisions to the Zoning Ordinance are in his computer. As you are aware, Mr. Rosa was discharged from the hospital on Friday afternoon. Mr. Rosa further informs me that during the period of his absence, there was a computer breakdown and his office was unable to print out the final revisions.

However, they are in the process of being printed out, and will be in the possession of the Planning Board no later than the end of this week.
