Dear Ms. Cameron:

I wish to acknowledge your recent letter concerning your eligibility for Mount Laurel housing in Piscataway. The eligibility requirements are established by the builder in accordance with the Mount Laurel principles. The situation which you suggest would not seem to allow for your eligibility. The court has no power to vary eligibility requirements in individual circumstances so I regret that I cannot assist you with this particular situation. Furthermore, you should understand that the Mount Laurel housing that you refer to is not being built under court order since the litigation involving the Township of Piscataway has not been completed. Therefore, any eligibility requirements established are those created by the builder through cooperation with the township.
