It is on this day of May, 1986, O R D E R E D:

- 1. Plaintiff's application for discovery with regard to Defendant, Township of Piscataway, shall be, and the same is hereby, denied;
- 2. Plaintiff's application to impose a condition upon the transfer of this litigation to the Affordable Housing Council which would effectively continue the restraints upon development contained in the Court's Judgment as to Piscataway dated September 17, 1985, shall be, and the same is hereby granted. The restrained sites are set forth on Schedule A, annexed hereto. The Piscataway Planning Board and Piscataway Board of Adjustment, or a duly designated agent of each, shall mail or otherwise serve on C. Roy Epps, President, Civic League of Greater New Brunswick, at 47-49 Throop Avenue, New Brunswick, NJ 08901, at least 14 days in advance of a meeting, a complete written copy of the agenda for such meeting, and shall mail a copy of the minutes and all resolutions adopted at every meeting to Mr. Epps at that address at the same time as copies of the minutes are mailed to the members of the respective Board.
- 3. Plaintiff's application for expansion of the restraints contained in the Judgment as to Piscataway dated September 17, 1985, to incorporate other lands not therein expressed, be, and the same is hereby, denied; and
- 4. Plaintiff's application to have the Rutgers Constitutional
 Law Clinic be permitted to continue its representation of the Urban

League before the Affordable Housing Council is neither granted or denied, the Court making no decision with respect to the substantive request.
