

This matter having been opened to the Court by attorneys for plaintiff, and by respective attorneys for defendants, and the court having considered the arguments of counsel and for good cause shown, $[**-y']f/f_{ac}$ /

It is therefore, on this <=gy_ day of February, 1975 ORDERED that

1. This action is certified as a class action. The class as represented by plaintiffs consists of low and moderate income persons, both white and non-white, who are seeking and unable to find adequate or suitable housing within their means in the 23 municipalities. Defendants' request that the Court direct notice to class members is denied.

2. Motions for a discovery coordinator and a protective order are denied as being premature.

This is without prejudice to an application which might be made on short notice by the plaintiffs to quash any notice of taking of depositions which would be repetitious or a hardship or otherwise amount to harassment in violation of the discovery rules.

3. There is no basis to join the County of Middlesex and the State of New Jersey as third party defendants, and those motions are denied.
